



ASSEMBLY FLOOR ALERT AB 222 (Adams) – OPPOSE

The California Resource Recovery Association, the Global Alliance for Incinerator Alternatives, and StopWaste.Org ask you to VOTE NO on AB 222.

AB 222 would:

- Count technologies that would consume resources that could be reduced, reused, recycled or composted as “recycling” under AB 939, California’s recycling law.
- Allow environmentally harmful waste-to-energy technologies to count as “renewable” energy.
- Eliminate existing environmental protections that prohibit a solid waste conversion facility from emitting air and water pollution.

Existing, proven technologies for recycling and composting are capable of providing more environmentally sound resource management, at lower costs, with far lower capital investment, and create more green jobs.

AB 222 is bad for the environment, bad for green jobs, and a big step backwards for sustainable resource management in California.
