

**With Senate Appropriations Committee - Hearing Scheduled July 13 - AB 876 on Agenda**

AB 888 - Plastic microbeads ban, passed Assembly May 22. Passed Senate Environmental Quality Committee June 17. Passed Senate Judiciary Committee July 1. CRRA attended and supported before both Committees.

AB 876 - Composting, local government planning for organics processing, passed Assembly June 3. Passed Senate Environmental Quality Committee July 1. CRRA attended Committee hearing and supported.

AB 1045 - Streamlined permitting, enhance composting to reduce GHG, passed Assembly May 28. Passed Senate Environmental Quality Committee July 1. CRRA attended Committee hearing and supported.

**Senate Environmental Quality Committee - Hearing Scheduled July 15**

AB 761 – Cap and trade funds for composting application projects, with amendments. Passed Senate Agriculture Committee June 30. CRRA will attend the Committee hearing and support AB 761 and AB 901.

AB 901 – Disposal enforcement authority for CalRecycle, passed Assembly June 1. CRRA support letter sent to Committee July 1.

AB 1435 - Exclude glass beverage containers from Toxic Packaging Act, passed Assembly on May 26

AB 1103 - "Food waste"/"food wastepaper" defined for purposes of AB 1826, passed Assembly May 26
