- BAAQMD – new draft Rule 13-2 summary – discussion entailed concerns over storage/stockpiling requirements being impractical and costly. Unclear what facilities/materials are covered under rule. Comments due February 28.

Jack Macy – public health and LEA engaged in food recovery enforcement – seeking meaningful tracking methods

Mary Lindemuth – working on edible food recovery, data gathering and tracking, Recyclist database an asset?; HFH working on hauler proposal/negotiations; current procurement 900 tpy of mulch, can't absorb compost.

Michele Young – still working to clarify differentiation on city and county responsibilities; Second Harvest has been excellent resource on edible food recovery, using students to conduct survey generators. County purchased truck for Second Harvest to use in pilot collection program. Source reduction efforts included surveys/strategies for/from residents; Ag Dept. Food Alliance working with small farms. No progress on procurement strategy pending finalization of SB 1383 regulations. RFP for development of recordkeeping templates underway.
